



## **ADMISSION APPEALS ARRANGEMENTS 2017/2018**

STEP Academy Trust is the admissions authority and the allocation of school places for La Fontaine Academy has been delegated to Bromley Local Authority School Admissions Team.

If you applied online and on time, you will receive an email or text alert telling you when you can log in to find out the result of your application, during the evening of 18 April 2017. You can also view the outcome of your application by downloading the 'ParentComms' App.

### **Important Information**

If your child has been offered a place at your first preference school, you will not be sent an outcome letter. You will be able to access the results of your application online as well as accept or decline the offer made.

You will be sent an email during the evening of 18 April 2017 with the outcome of your application. Please wait until you have received the email before logging onto the Pan London Admissions website.

Offers must be accepted or declined by Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2017 at [www.eadmissions.org.uk](http://www.eadmissions.org.uk).

Applicants who are not offered a place at La Fontaine Academy will be given a right of appeal, in line with the School Admissions Appeal Code (DfE, 1st February 2012). Clerks Associates UK manage the appeals process on behalf of La Fontaine Academy.

Academy Primary admission appeals to be heard between early June and 21<sup>st</sup> July 2017

Appellants will receive at least 10 school days' notice of their appeal hearing date.

Appellants must submit their additional evidence and the admission authority to submit their evidence at least 10 school days prior to the hearing date.

Wherever possible decision letters will be sent to appellants within 5 school days of the hearing, or, where multiple appeals for a school are heard on more than one day, within 5 school days of the last hearing day for that school.

Outcome letters will give full details of how to lodge an appeal for La Fontaine Academy along with advice on the relevant timescales and deadlines.
